3. Legal basis for processing

The legality of the data processing is based on the realization of tasks in the public interest according to Art. 6 subsection 1 lit. e) GDPR and § 2 subsection 1 Hochschulgesetz Rheinland-Pfalz: promotion of young academics. As well as Art. 6 subsection 1 lit. e) GDPR and § 2 Subsection 11 Hochschulgesetz Rheinland-Pfalz: information about the fulfillment of tasks in the public interest.

4. Necessity of the provision of personal data

The participants of the conference are not required by law or contract to provide their personal data. Therefore, no disadvantages may arise if you do not provide your data.
